Guest of Honor: The Doubleclicks



The Doubleclicks (Laser Malena-Webber and Aubrey Turner) are a Portland & LA-based musical duo who mix comedy, messages and geek culture in charming, catchy songs. Since debuting with a weekly YouTube songwriting project in 2011, the Doubleclicks have carved out a space in geek and songwriting communities with their message of empowerment and their penchant for involving their community of listeners in the creation of their music and videos. The Doubleclicks' 2012 album Lasers and Feelings and 2015 album President Snakes hit the Billboard charts in comedy.

The Doubleclicks tour the country, playing everywhere from music venues to comedy clubs, game stores, and at events like San Diego Comic-Con, PAX, JoCoCruise and more. The band's loyal fanbase frequently participates in their music videos and has elevated the band by funding two albums via Kickstarter projects raising a total of more than \$135,000. The Doubleclicks have written theme songs and created commercials for popular game brands Cards Against Humanity and Fluxx, for a Nerdist partnership with Totinos, and for many podcasts and web series.

Tim Cavanagh - Tim Cavanagh is a local Chicago comic who has appeared on Showtime, WGN, and Comedy Central. He is best known to Dr. Demento fans for his classic songs "I Wanna Kiss Her" and "99 Dead Babboons." Tim routinely performs at comedy clubs, concert halls, and corporate gigs and is a regular on The Bob and Tom Show.

Carrie Dahlby - Carrie Dahlby is a classically trained opera singer from the Chicago area who lends her talents to many of the other FuMP artists for their own music. Carrie has released three studio albums and is best known for her songs about being a parent.



Earlier this year Carrie was Music Guest of Honor status at Capricon.

Robbie Ellis - Robbie Ellis is an overeducated wordy piano comedian. He performs regularly at The Paper Machete in Chicago, he was the host of WFMT's Classical Cabaret, and he's played the New York Funny Songs Festival. He's also performed at Davenport's and The Second City Training Center in Chicago; The PIT in New York; ComedySportz Philadelphia; and all over his native New Zealand.

Amy Engelhardt - Amy was a member of The Bobs from 1998-2011. She's won a bunch of awards for songwriting, scored a rock musical adaptation of Henry Fielding's TOM JONES Off-Broadway and other musicals about Carl Sagan and Nikola Tesla, and worked with folks including The Flying Karamazov Brothers, Weird Al, Jill Sobule and Spinal Tap.



Insane Ian - Ian is a comedy-musician from Chicago with a penchant for video games and a strange Spider-Man fetish. Recently knighted a "comedy music god" by Dr. Demento, Ian has made a name for himself with his quick wit and video game-related song parodies. Ian will also be your host for the weekend.



The Library Bards - The Library Bards are a nerd parody band consisting of Bonnie Gordon (ABC's The Quest, left) and Xander Jeanneret (TBS' King of the Nerds, right). They take popular songs and transform them into the nerdy versions they should have been in the first place! Their new album BomBARDed was is now available.



Lauren Mayer - Lauren began playing the piano at age 3 and discovered her penchant for writing comedy songs shortly thereafter. Her early influences included Alan Sherman, Dr. Demento, and Tom Lehrer. In 2017 her song "The Sexual Harassment Prevention Song" went viral, garnering nearly 3 million views on Faceook and YouTube.



Expect some profanity here but not an excessive amount.


